Year 5 Educational Visit to the Tower of London - Friday 8th June 2018

As part of their Crime and Punishment learning theme this term, we have arranged for our Year 5 children to have the exciting opportunity of visiting the Tower of London. After exploring the Tower, they will take part in a workshop where the children will put themselves in the shoes of a prisoner and hear exciting stories of the Tower's dark history. They will then explore some of the historic spaces used to hold prisoners. We are planning to have an outdoor picnic lunch, however, if the weather is bad we have arranged for the children to have their lunch undercover.

We will be travelling by coach to London, leaving Joy Lane promptly at 9am and will return to Joy Lane at approximately 5:45pm.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or chocolate). If you would like the School kitchen to provide a packed lunch for your child, **please indicate this on the slip below.**

Pupils should wear school uniform and comfortable footwear on this day. In addition, if the weather is hot and sunny, we recommend that your child brings a sun hat, alternatively a light raincoat may be useful. If you wish your child to wear sunscreen, please apply this at home before coming to School. Pupils must not bring sunscreen for application during the day.

The trip is subsidised by the Friends of Joy Lane and we are only asking for a contribution of £14.00 towards the costs. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. Please complete and return the attached permission slip to the School office by Friday 18th May. **Your £14 contribution can be paid in cash, a cheque payable to 'Joy Lane Primary School', card payment or via our on-line payment system.**
