Perfect Packed Lunch

Children at Joy Lane Primary School have the chance to view their creative writing and artwork on display at The Beaney House of Art & Knowledge, in Canterbury, by entering the Perfect Packed Lunch Awards.

The competition, organised by the KM Group's charity department, invites youngsters to devise a genuine or fantasy packed lunch. To enter, they must submit a drawing of their creation and write about what makes it special. Children can submit their entries in a variety of categories including: Famous Artist, Book Character, Knight, Superhero, Celebrity, Fairytale, Pirate Captain, Historic figure, Princess, Healthy, and Cheesy.

Every online entry submitted to the Perfect Packed Lunch Awards will be converted into an online recipe card. Judges will pick category finalists and winners to invite to an awards ceremony at the prestigious Beaney House of Art & Knowledge, where their art will go on display for the summer.

Once your child has decided which category they are entering they should:

1. Draw a picture of their perfect packed lunch. Use an A4 piece of paper and aim to fill the entire piece of paper with the drawing. Make sure it's in landscape.
2. Write a WOW sentence or advertising slogan to promoting their Prefect Packed Lunch.
3. Tell us about their perfect packed lunch and how it was made or created.
4. List the ingredients (real or imaginary) in their perfect packed lunch.
