Year 1 Summer Educational Visit to Leeds Castle – Tuesday 24th May 2016

As part of their learning theme this term, we have arranged for our Year 1 children to have the exciting opportunity of visiting Leeds Castle in Maidstone. The children will be visiting the extensive grounds, studying the castle and naming the various different parts and they will then have the opportunity to spend some time in the play area – let's hope the children have some energy left! We are planning to have an outdoor picnic lunch, however, if the weather is bad we have arranged for the children to have their lunch undercover.

We will be travelling by coach to Leeds Castle, leaving Joy Lane just after 9am and returning in time for the end of the School day.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink which we are planning to eat outside – weather permitting! (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or chocolate). If you would like the School kitchen to provide a packed lunch for your child, **please indicate this on the slip below**. There is a gift shop at the Castle and pupils may bring a **small** amount of money for a souvenir. (no more than £3 please in a named envelope / purse. They will be responsible for this on the day.

Pupils should wear school uniform and comfortable footwear on this day. In addition, if the weather is hot and sunny, we recommend that your child brings a sun hat, alternatively a light raincoat may be useful. If you wish your child to wear sunscreen, please apply this at home before coming to School. Pupils must not bring sunscreen for application during the day.

As previously advised, the trip is subsidised by the Friends of Joy Lane and we are only asking for a contribution of £10.00 towards the costs. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. Please complete and return the attached permission slip to the School office by Thursday 19th May. **Your £10 contribution can be paid in cash, a cheque payable to 'Joy Lane Primary School' or via our on-line payment system.**
