Year 4 Educational Visit to Canterbury Cathedral – Thursday 14th July 2016

On Thursday 14th July, Year 4 will be visiting Canterbury Cathedral for an exciting day that will bring to life their previous History learning about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

They will have the opportunity to recreate Anglo-Saxon and Viking artefacts with art materials, explore the Cathedral archives investigating items from their collections, and even dress up in historical costumes!

We will be leaving School after morning registration at 9:15am, travelling by coach and the School's minibus, and will return in time for the end of the School day.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or chocolate) which we are planning to eat in the Cathedral precincts – weather permitting! If your child is entitled to Free School Meals and you would like the School kitchen to provide a packed lunch for your child, please indicate this on the slip below.

Pupils should wear School uniform and comfortable shoes. In addition, if the weather is hot and sunny we recommend your child brings a sun hat, alternatively a light raincoat may be useful. If you wish your child to wear sunscreen, please apply this at home before coming to School. There may be an opportunity to visit the gift shop and the children can bring a maximum of £3 which they will be responsible for on the day.

As previously advised, the visit is subsidised by the Friends of Joy Lane and we are only asking for a contribution of £6 towards the entrance and travel costs. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. Please complete and return the attached permission slip to the School office by Monday 11th July.
