Dear Parents and Carers

This letter is a quick reminder of which year groups are swimming in the New Year.

At Joy Lane we are extremely fortunate to have this wonderful resource on site and I am sure you will agree that the children benefit immensely and learn an essential life skill that will stay with them forever. The Governors and Headteacher feel the lessons offer extremely good value for money and therefore will continue to subsidize the cost of school lessons to ensure the high quality teaching continues. Our first priority is keeping your child safe and therefore as a school we are committed to increasing the number of children who are able to confidently swim and see this as being particularly important given the school's location close to the sea.

This year our swimming programme follows the Amateur Swimming Association National Plan of teaching swimming in recognised stages from 1-7 plus advanced stages 8-10 alongside awards for rainbow distance 5 metres onwards. These levels are recognised qualifications at swimming schools across the country. We propose to offer consultations with your child's swimming teacher so that you are informed of the progress they are making during their lessons. You will also have the opportunity to purchase the relevant certificates and badges during the school year if you would like.

I would like to thank all families within the Joy Lane Primary School community who support swimming lessons which is obviously essential in allowing us to make swimming cost effective. I would also like to remind you that 74% of parents and carers who responded to our most recent questionnaire believe that £40-£50 is an acceptable financial contribution towards a year's swimming lessons.

Once again, we offer three different payment options for your child's swimming lessons.

**Payment based on number of children at Joy Lane Primary School in Years 1 - 6**

Two pupils	£60 per year
Three pupils or more	£80 per year
