## Visit to the Roman Museum, Canterbury – Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2016

To bring to life this term's focus of 'Rocking Romans', we have arranged to take the children to the Roman Museum in Canterbury on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2016.

Please ensure your child is at School ready for registration at 8.50am as we will be leaving for Canterbury shortly after 9am. The children will be back at Joy Lane in time for the end of the School day.

Staff and pupils will be travelling by bus to and from Canterbury Bus Station; it is then a five minute walk to the Museum. The children will then have the opportunity to take part in two interactive workshops:

- Roman technology - The children experience first-hand the jobs of Roman workers and slaves. During the session children learn how to grind grain using a rotary quern, hammer a Roman coin (to take home as a souvenir) and build and fire mini catapults.
- Roman Everyday Life - During the workshop children will take on the role of archaeologists, investigating and handling real artefacts from Roman Canterbury.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch, including drinks, (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or chocolate). If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like the School kitchen to provide a packed lunch for your child, please indicate this on the slip below.

Pupils should wear school uniform (no trainers) and a warm coat on this day.

As usual we will need extra adults to help with this trip. If you would like to help, please contact your child's teacher no later than Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> January.
