







## Class Dojo Parent App Log in

We have been using the Class Dojo at Joy Lane School since June 2016 as a fantastic behaviour system which rewards positive behaviours in line with our School behaviour policy. The children are very enthusiastic about Class Dojo and are keen to earn points which accrue to enable them to collect house point tokens and Golden Dojo raffle tickets. Subsequently, certificates (for 100, 150 and 200) Class Dojo points) and prizes (which the friends of Joy Lane have kindly sponsored) can be earned by pupils as recognition of their efforts.





A summary of the positive Dojo awards are below, this outlines the Titles of the awards earned and gives a brief example of when one of these Dojos would be awarded.

### What each Dojo means - Positive

 <b>Being Kind</b> • Going above and beyond to be nice	 <b>Olympic Maths (+1)</b> • Beating last weeks score
 <b>On Task</b> • Engaged in learning/task	 <b>Olympic Maths (+5)</b> • Moving on to the next level
 <b>Flying High</b> • Doing really well in lesson	 <b>Teamwork</b> • Working well with others



### What each Dojo means - Positive

 <b>Participating in Class Discussion</b> • Taking an active part in their learning	 <b>Helping others</b> • Going above and beyond to help others
 <b>Persistence in trying</b> • Not giving up when things get difficult	 <b>Respecting other</b> • Showing respect towards others
 <b>WOW moment</b> • Having an amazing idea • When you are finding things difficult, and you finally get it!	



As well as positive behaviours the app also logs negative behaviours which is in line with our Behaviour Policy as follows:

- 1 = Reminder
- 2 = Warning
- 3 = Thinking time (10 minutes)
- 4 = Red Dojo



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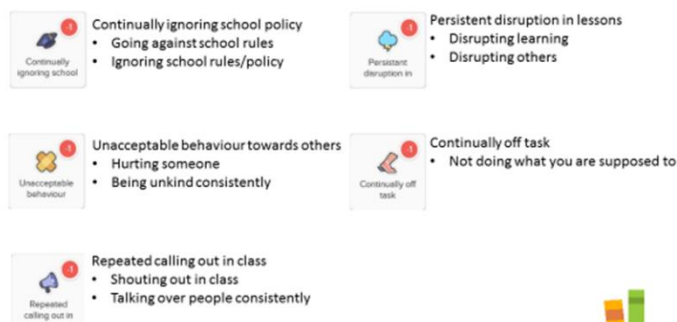
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A summary of the negative Dojo awards is below, this outlines the Titles of the awards and gives a brief example of when one of these Dojos would be awarded.

## What each Dojo means - Negative



The red Dojo points are not applicable for the children in Yr R. The Early Years' curriculum identifies that children in this age group should work towards understanding appropriate and inappropriate forms of behaviours.

In summary, following on from our successful workshops regarding access to your child's Class Dojo Account, we are pleased to be able to share your log in details for this app. These online details will also enable each child to access their avatar which they will be able to alter the design of from home. Please follow the instructions on the attached piece of paper to access your child's Dojo account. Once you have activated your child's Class Dojo account and downloaded the app, you will receive an alert each time your child earns a Class Dojo positive or negative point. The app will allow you to look back at your child's Class Dojo points up to two weeks prior to the day and see what they are doing well during their time in School.

Once you have signed up to Class Dojo, as a Parent / Carer, you may notice a tab for messaging. This is a feature of Class Dojo that we, as a School, have decided to disable. It may still appear that you are able to message your child's teacher, however, they will be unable to receive the message.

We hope you will enjoy sharing your child's successes with them as much as we do, using the Class Dojo app!
