Year 3 Visit to the Roman Museum, Heritage Museum & The Beaney in Canterbury – Tuesday 31st January 2017

To bring to life this term's focus of 'Rocking Romans', we have arranged to take the children to the Roman Museum, Heritage Museum and The Beaney in Canterbury on Tuesday 31st January 2017.

Please ensure your child is at School ready for registration at the slightly earlier time of 8.40am as we will be leaving for Canterbury shortly after 8.50am. The children will be back at Joy Lane in time for the end of the School day. The cost of the visit is £9 which covers the cost of the bus fare and the workshops.

Staff and pupils will be travelling by bus to and from Canterbury Bus Station; it is then a ten minute walk to the Museums. The children will then have the opportunity to take part in two interactive workshops:

- Roman technology - The children experience first-hand the jobs of Roman workers and slaves. During the session children learn how to grind grain using a rotary quern, hammer a Roman coin (to take home as a souvenir) and build and fire mini catapults.
- Roman Everyday Life - During the workshop children will take on the role of archaeologists, investigating and handling real artefacts from Roman Canterbury.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch, including drinks, (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or chocolate). If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like the School kitchen to provide a packed lunch for your child, please indicate this on the slip below.

Pupils should wear school uniform (no trainers) and a warm coat on this day.
