Access Arrangements at Joy Lane Primary School Site

I would like to welcome you back to the new term and hope that you have all had a great summer break and made the most of the wonderful sunny weather.

I write to you just before you come onto our School site tomorrow to inform you of the new arrangements around our School site for vehicle and pedestrian access whilst our building works continue for the expansion of the new classrooms and new access and egress from our School site.

The School site does look very different at the moment as the major works have been undertaken but, as ever, we will be taking the opportunity for our children to observe and learn and to be part of the planning for new play zones and landscaping. Inside our School building, classrooms have been polished, painted and are ready to welcome the children back into the wonderful learning environments.

Due to unforeseen circumstances the car park is not finished as first planned; this is due to delays in relocating services. As a result of this we have had to divert pathways around the School site to ensure safety of our whole community. On Tuesday morning, you will be guided by staff on the route to take to drop off/pick up the children.

For those of you who enter the School site from Valkyrie Road alleyway, you will be able to access the Main School building by following the diverted pathway around the Early Years building and the Children's centre and past the extended pathway adjacent to our Swimming Pool and onto the Main building. Access from Joy Lane will also be signposted.

The Breakfast Club remains in the same place, in the Main School Hall but only 4 parking spaces are available to drop off children, so please be extra vigilant and, if possible, park outside the School grounds.

We have moved the Oystercatchers After School Club to our Oysters SRP; this will ensure a safe outdoor play space for the children and afford vehicle access to the top playground, for picking up the children, which I know you appreciate and value.

I will also ensure that there are regular updates on our School website regarding the progress of building works and alternative arrangements.

I would like to thank you in advance for your support and understanding whilst we make improvements to our School and the Staff and I look forward to welcoming you tomorrow morning.
